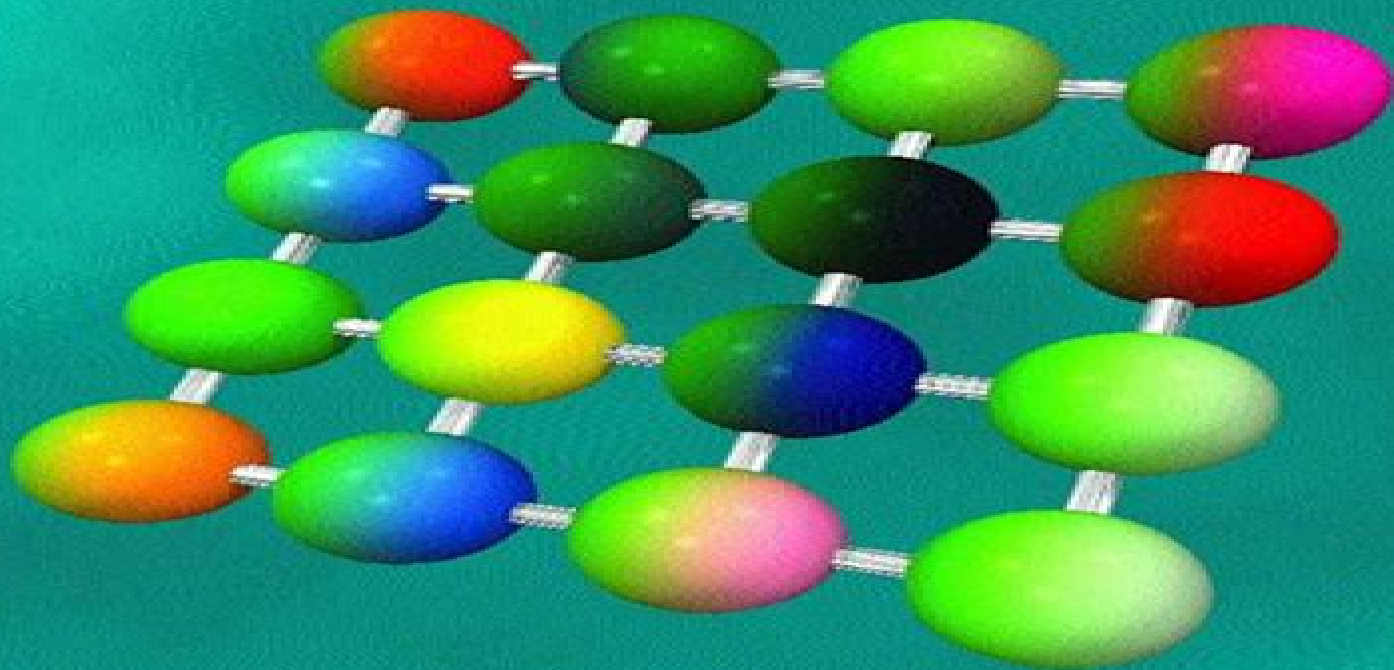

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Classroom Discourse Analysis Frances Christie, 2005-01-01 This book offers a model of classroom discourse analysis that uses systemic functional linguistic theory and associated genre theory to develop a view of classroom episodes as curriculum genres some of which operate in turn as part of larger unities of work called curriculum macrogenres Drawing on Bernstein's work Christie argues that two registers operate in pedagogic discourse a regulative register to do with the goals and directions of the discourse and an instructional register to do with the particular content or knowledge at issue Each can be shown to be realized in distinctive clusters of choices in the grammar The operation of the regulative register determines the initiation pacing sequencing and evaluation of the overall pedagogic activity The book sets out its methodology in detail by reference to a number of classroom texts and a range of school subjects Overall schools emerge as sites of symbolic control in a culture

Corpus Linguistics Geoffrey Sampson, Diana McCarthy, 2005-10-01 Corpus Linguistics seeks to provide a comprehensive sampling of real life usage in a given language and to use these empirical data to test language hypotheses Modern corpus linguistics began fifty years ago but the subject has seen explosive growth since the early 1990s These days corpora are being used to advance virtually every aspect of

language study from computer processing techniques such as machine translation to literary stylistics social aspects of language use and improved language teaching methods Because corpus linguistics has grown fast from small beginnings newcomers to the field often find it hard to get their bearings Important papers can be difficult to track down This volume reprints forty two articles on corpus linguistics by an international selection of authors which comprehensively illustrate the directions in which the subject is developing It includes articles that are already recognized as classics and others which deserve to become so supplemented with editorial introductions relating the individual contributions to the field as a whole This collection of readings will be useful to students of corpus linguistics at both undergraduate and postgraduate level as well as academics researching this fascinating area of linguistics

Multifactorial Analysis in Corpus Linguistics Stefan Thomas Gries, 2005-04-29 This book presents a novel analysis of the word order alternation of English transitive phrasal verbs Particle Movement from a cognitive functional and psycholinguistic perspective Its main objective however is a methodological one namely to demonstrate the superiority of corpus based multifactorial and probabilistic approaches to grammatical phenomena over traditional analyses based on acceptability judgements and minimal pair tests The advantages resulting from the advocated multifactorial approach to Particle Movement are Particle Movement can be described at a previously unknown level of detail all determinants ever proposed to govern the alternation can be integrated into a single hypothesis explaining the alternation constructions can be compared to each other with respect to their degree of prototypicality and similarity it is possible to actually predict with a high degree of accuracy which of the two word orders native speakers will subconsciously choose in the natural production of speech and text thereby passing the most rigorous test conceivable finally competing hypotheses can be compared in terms of their predictive power Apart from these methodological points the study also addresses the more theoretical and linguistic question of how to explain such results It is argued that theories of language production that rest on the notion of processing effort are contrary to some contemporary analysts not ideally suited to explain such phenomena and that interactive activation models of language production allow for a more elegant interpretation and implementation of the results

Empirical Linguistics Geoffrey Sampson, 2002-09-12 Linguistics has become an empirical science again after several decades when it was preoccupied with speakers hazy intuitions about language structure With a mixture of English language case studies and more theoretical analyses Geoffrey Sampson gives an overview of some of the new findings and insights about the nature of language which are emerging from investigations of real life speech and writing often although not always using computers and electronic language samples corpora Concrete evidence is brought to bear to resolve long standing questions such as Is there one English language or many Englishes and Do different social groups use characteristically elaborated or restricted language codes Sampson shows readers how to use some of the new techniques for themselves giving a step by step recipe book method for applying a quantitative technique that was invented by Alan Turing in the World War II code breaking work at Bletchley Park and has

been rediscovered and widely applied in linguistics fifty years later
