Spontaneous Generation - correct answer The hypothesis that living organisms arise from nonliving matter. A "vital force" forms life.

Biogenesis - correct answer The hypothesis that the living organisms arise from preexisting life.

Leeuwenhoeke - correct answer Developed the first microscope.

Pasteur - correct answer Showed that microbes are responsible for fermentation. Demonstrated that these spoilage bacteria could be killed by heat.

Koch - correct answer Proved that a bacterium causes anthrax. Developed Koch's Postulates.

Koch's Postulates - correct answer The microorganism must be present in all cases of the disease.

The microorganism can be isolated from the diseased host and grown in a laboratory setting.

The microorganism will cause disease when injected into a healthy host.

The microorganism must be reisolated from the NEW host and shown to be the same as the microorganism previously identified.

Jenner - correct answer First vaccination.

Erlch - correct answer Founding father of chemotherapy

Fleming - correct answer Discovered first antibiotic

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
