Celebrating Women Choi Chatterjee, 2012-02-07 The first International Women's Day was celebrated in Copenhagen in 1910 and adopted by the Bolsheviks in 1913 as a means to popularize their political program among factory women in Russia. By 1918 Women's Day had joined May Day and the anniversary of the October Revolution as the most important national holidays on the calendar. Choi Chatterjee analyzes both Bolshevik attitudes towards women and invented state rituals surrounding Women's Day in Russia and the early Soviet Union to demonstrate the ways in which these celebrations were a strategic form of cultural practice that marked the distinctiveness of Soviet civilization, legitimized the Soviet mission for women, and articulated the Soviet construction of gender. Unlike previous scholars who have criticized the Bolsheviks for repudiating their initial commitment to Marxist feminism, Chatterjee has discovered considerable continuity in the way that they imagined the ideal woman and her role in a communist society. Through the years, Women's Day celebrations temporarily empowered women as they sang revolutionary songs, acted as strong protagonists in plays, and marched in processions carrying slogans about gender equality. In speeches, state policies, reports, historical sketches, plays, cartoons, and short stories, the passive Russian woman was transformed into an iconic Soviet Woman, one who could survive, improvise, and prevail over the most challenging of circumstances. *Celebrating Women* Choi Chatterjee, 2002

The Stalin Cult in East Germany and the Making of the Postwar Soviet Empire, 1945-1961 Alexey Tikhomirov, 2022-03-28 This book examines the construction, dissemination, and reception of the Stalin cult in East Germany from the end of World War II to the building of the Berlin Wall. By exporting Stalin's cult to the Eastern bloc, Moscow aspired to symbolically unite the communist states in an imagined cult community pivoting around the Soviet leader. Based on Russian and German archives, this work analyzes the emergence of the Stalin cult's transnational dimension. On one hand, it looks at how Soviet representations of power were transferred and adapted in the former enemy's country. On the other hand, it reconstructs spaces of agency where different agents and generations interpreted, manipulated, and used the Stalin cult to negotiate social identities and everyday life. This study reveals both the dynamics of Stalinism as a political system after the Cold War began and the foundations of modern politics through mass mobilization, emotional bonding, and social engineering in Soviet-style societies. As an integral part of the global history of communism, this book opens up a comparative, entangled perspective on the ways in which veneration of Stalin and other nationalistic cults were established in socialist states across Europe and beyond.

Contemporary Ukrainian and Baltic Art Svitlana Biedarieva, 2021-09-21 This volume focuses on political and social expressions in contemporary art of Ukraine, Estonia, Lithuania, and Latvia. European Court of Human Rights ECtHR The ECtHR located in Strasbourg France is widely regarded as the most effective international human rights court in existence Russian citizens whose rights have been violated at home have brought tens of thousands of cases to the ECtHR over the past two decades But only one of these cases resulted in a finding of gender discrimination by the ECtHR and that case was brought by a man By comparison the Court has found gender discrimination more frequently in decisions on Turkish cases *Courting Gender Justice* explores the obstacles that confront citizens activists and lawyers who try to bring gender discrimination cases to court To shed light on the factors that make rare victories possible in discrimination cases the book draws comparisons among forms of discrimination faced by women and LGBT people in Russia and Turkey Based on interviews with human rights and feminist activists and lawyers in Russia and Turkey this engaging book grounds the law in the personal experiences of individual people fighting to defend their rights

The Oxford Handbook of Propaganda Studies Jonathan Auerbach, Russ Castronovo, 2013 Derived from the word to propagate the idea and practice of propaganda concerns nothing less than the ways in which human beings communicate particularly with respect to the creation and widespread dissemination of attitudes images and beliefs Much larger than its pejorative connotations suggest propaganda can more neutrally be understood as a central means of organizing and shaping thought and perception a practice that has been a pervasive feature of the twentieth century and that touches on many fields It has been seen as both a positive and negative force although abuses under the Third Reich and during the Cold War have caused the term to stand in most recently as a synonym for untruth and brazen manipulation Propaganda analysis of the 1950s to 1989 too often took the form of empirical studies about the efficacy of specific methods with larger questions about the purposes and patterns of mass persuasion remaining unanswered In the present moment where globalization and transnationality are arguably as important as older nation forms when media enjoy near ubiquity throughout the globe when various fundamentalisms are ascendant and when debates rage about neoliberalism it is urgent that we have an up to date resource that considers propaganda as a force of culture writ large The handbook will include twenty two essays by leading scholars from a variety of disciplines divided into three sections In addition to dealing with the thorny question of definition the handbook will take up an expansive set of assumptions and a full range of approaches that move propaganda beyond political campaigns and warfare to examine a wide array of cultural contexts and practices
